

Meals for Kids in Ottawa County During COVID-19 School Closures

Food is a significant concern for many students and families at this time, and we have been working closely with schools and community agencies to meet this need.

Please note the following are true for all of the school district food distributions listed below:

- Parents may participate in ANY of our local district food service plans now through April 5, 2020. Refer to the links below for specific information for each district. Most are offering multiple pick up opportunities to receive meals for multiple days to limit the number of trips required.
- Though some local district sites refer to all children “age 18 & under,” they realize that Special Needs includes students “up to age 26” and are prepared to serve these families.
- There is NO cost for the meals, regardless of whether or not the family qualifies for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program.
- Children do NOT need to be present with the parent(s) to pick up meals.
- For planning purposes, some districts are requesting advance information. Please visit the district links below and complete the form if applicable.

Monday's deliveries will consist of two days of breakfast and two days of lunch. Wednesday's deliveries will consist of three days of breakfast and three days of lunch.

A parent may pick up meals for children in their home 18 and under. Students do not have to attend with their parents. We welcome any family in our community to participate.

Hudsonville Public Schools will offer free breakfast and lunch for children in need during the statewide school closure. Starting next week we are moving to Monday & Wednesday distribution. On Mondays we will give 2 days' worth of breakfasts & lunches. Wednesday we will give 3 days' worth of breakfasts & lunches. Thursday, Hand 2 Hand does their food distribution to cover for the weekend. This adjustment will give all of our food service staff & volunteers a bit of a break as we work on meal planning for the following week.

ANY child age 0-18 (or up to age 26, for young adults with special needs) can get meals on weekdays through April 3, 2020, from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm at the following locations:

- Hudsonville High School – 5037 32nd Ave, Hudsonville
- Riley Middle School- 2745 Riley Street, Hudsonville
- Baldwin Middle School -3835 Baldwin Street, Hudsonville
- Alward Elementary School- 3811 Port Sheldon St, Hudsonville

You may drive-up or walk to any site, simply grab and go. Breakfast will be available at the same time for those families who wish to take it home for future use. Please also note that a parent may pick up meals for children at home. The schools will actually still be closed, but the meals will be served in their parking lots.

ZPS will host 27 locations to provide meals to community members ages 18 and under. Routes will run every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Routes on Monday and Wednesday will provide four meals per person consisting of two breakfasts and two lunches. Friday routes will provide six meals per person. Please note parents can pick up meals for children and children do not need to be present to receive food. Children do not need to be ZPS students to receive food. This service is open to all families in our community. If your child has a food allergy, please email foodservice@zps.org for full assistance.

With all locations, we ask that participants engage in social distancing and practice proper hygiene before and after meal service pick up.
